Minutes – May 12, 2026 - DRAFT COPY

The Owatonna Human Rights Commission (OHRC) met on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, in the Meeting Room of the Charles S. Crandall Center at City Hall. Chairman Bjore called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Bjore, Bendor, Hult, and Zinsli and Administrative Coordinator Clawson. Commissioners Seykora and Hill were unable to attend.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Bjore welcomed everyone to the meeting. Commissioner Hult made a motion to approve the Meeting Agenda as presented, Commissioner Zinsli seconded the motion, all members present voted aye in approval. Following review of the April 12, 2026 OHRC Meeting Minutes, Commissioner Bjore requested minor clerical update and then made a motion for approval. Commissioner Bendorf seconded the motion, and all members present voted aye in approval.
