City staff has been removing items to be preserved or reused. Note: Stage came apart in one piece and will be used in the IT room. Carpeting and painting in Building Inspections area at City Hall. Carpeting and painting at West Hills Social Commons. Merrill Hall – a contract with ICS has been approved by Council to move forward with planning for mechanical upgrades and remodeling of the building. Initial plans are to create a more welcoming area for the Little Theater and expand day care. The Little Theater is also raising money to upgrade rigging and lighting.
